The Easter offering will go to She is Safe. Our mission partner, Michele Rickett, the CEO, works with young women and girls who have been or are vulnerable to being sex trafficked. These women and girls are often abandoned by their families, who feel that this has brought shame to them.

Since 2002, She Is Safe's mission has been to prevent, rescue, and restore women and girls from suffering abuse and exploitation in high-risk places, equipping them to build lives of freedom and faith for a strong future. She Is Safe operates in regions with high rates of trafficking of women and girls: India, Indonesia, the Middle East, Myanmar, Nepal, and South Sudan. The ministry partners with indigenous denominations and parachurch organizations, confronting the pervasive issues of sex trafficking and abuse of young girls and women. This results in a ripple effect of change for families and communities toward valuing girls as God's image-bearers. These changes span generations rather than offering temporary fixes. Last year, She Is Safe programs directly benefited 25,871 lives.

The gifted Michelle Badejo is keeping us on track. We've set some ambitious goals, and we will keep you informed as we figure this out.
